What does GIFT look like?

Hospitality, Community Building and Opening Prayer— We begin by enjoying a meal and each other then we move into prayer.

Opening Experience For All Ages— Through scripture, drama, trivia, games, discussion this shared experience will set the focus for the session.

In-depth Learning Experience— This will provide an opportunity to learn about the topic in a deeper way. This learning may occur in the whole group, age specific groups or an activity center/workshop format.
